Guidelines for Young Scientist Award, Best Dissertation Award and Best Paper Award

Instructions: All the perspectives Scientists/Researcher/PhD Scholars are advised to follow the following guideline for preparing their Research Report. The title should be limited to 20 words. Abstract should be typed in Times New Roman Letter with 1.5 Space between lines and 12 Font Size in Microsoft Word Document. The Abstract Word Limit should be in-between 150-200 words. The Full paper should be between 6000-7000 words. Authors are advised to strictly follow the APA guidelines for referencing. The work should be innovative and contemporary in nature. It should be within the domain of the conference subthemes or related inter-disciplinary work. In case of Best Dissertation Award, the PhD students who have been awarded during last 02 years are eligible to apply for this award. The award committee will examine the reports first, and then will shortlist for final presentation in the conference. All the applicants are required to register for the conference. The winner is entitled to be reimbursed with Third AC train fare (up-down) by shortest route. The winner will be honoured with a certificate and memento. All authors are advised to submit a declaration that the research work/paper has not been presented anywhere/not submitted anywhere for publication (partly/full); the work is original, and free from plagiarism. A plagiarism report should be submitted to the organiser of the conference before the presentation for award.

Guidelines for Best Poster Award

Instructions: The applicants for Best Poster Awards should follow the same format as mentioned above. **The Size of the Poster should be 48" x 60"**. It should be neat and clean in terms of typing, clarity, visibility and good content. The font should be in Times New Roman. Referencing should be in APA style. The participants should be present in front of their poster from beginning to end of the session. **The poster should be prepared on flex printing so that it can be hanged on a stand during the presentation.** The entire poster should be handed over to the representatives of the Conference. All authors are advised to submit a declaration that the poster has not been presented anywhere; the work is original and free from plagiarism. A plagiarism report should be submitted to the organiser of the conference before the presentation for award.

Industry/Organisational Award for “Best Practices in Mental Health”

Instructions: All the perspective organisations are advised to follow the following guideline for preparing their Report on “**Best Practices in Mental Health**” before submitting their nomination to the organising committee. The summary Report should be in-between 2000-3000 words. The work should be innovative meaningful, effective and contemporary in nature. It should be within the domain of the conference subthemes or related inter-disciplinary work. The award committee will examine the reports first, and then will shortlist for final presentation in the conference. All the applicants should register for the conference. The entry fee for this award is 20,000 INR for Indian Organisations, all developing countries and 500USD for Multi National Companies across nations. The winner will be honoured with a certificate and memento in the valedictory functions.
