In addition, the state Odisha has a tradition of rich cultural heritage, sanctuaries and handicrafts. The famous Chilka Lake (Largest in Asia) is just 1.5hrs travel from Bhubaneswar. The weather (Temperature 19-30 degree) is quite calm and cool with the on-set of winter and quite pleasant for travel and tours. The City is well connected with Air, rail and road to major cities of India with direct flights, train and intercity buses. The local people are fluent in Odia (local language), Hindi (national language) and English (international) language.
